Open Pairs: A 3000+	B 1000-3,000	C 0-1000
499ers Pairs: A 300-499	B 100-300	C 0-100 (May be varied based on participation)
0-750 NLM Pairs: A 500-799	B 200-499	C 0-199 (May be varied based on participation)

In pair events, strats are based as an average of the total master points of the pair. In any event or flight with a master point upper limit, no individual's MP total may exceed that limit.

Entry Fees: \$38 per pair per session Friday and Saturday and \$160 per team on Sunday. Half-price for players under 26 years old.

Entry Prerequisite: Players must be up-to-date ACBL members. Lapsed members and non-members may sign up at the tournament to become active members. Lapsed members must renew with a minimum of a one-year membership. Never been an ACBL member? Join the ACBL on site at half-price and play your first session free! Or you may sign up for a free limited membership.

Parking Policy: PARKING IS LIMITED - carpooling is recommended. DO NOT park in spots marked "Reserved." Overflow parking is available across the street in an Edison High School parking lot.
